

## Community Car for Bühl

## Who's it for?

- Residents of Bühl who are not good on their feet.
- People of any age who need help with everyday tasks.
- Whatever the occasion—shopping, appointments with the doctor or the hairdresser, visiting friends.

## How does it work?

- Available on Tuesday and Thursday, from 08:00 to 16:00.
- Range: Tübingen, including all districts: Rottenburg, including all districts. Other destinations by prior arrangement only.
- Registration: Monday and Wednesday, between 09:00 and 12:00; call 0157/58 49 09 73.
- Volunteer drivers in their private vehicles collect passengers at home and take them to where they want to go and back again. Journeys are free of charge, but drivers are grateful for donations.
- Parking charges must be paid by the passenger. Passengers can also take advantage of their blue EU Disability Card, if they have one.
- Passengers and drivers are correspondingly insured.
- This is <u>not</u> an ambulance service. Journeys paid for by your health insurance company are <u>not possible</u>. In some cases, passengers may take a rollator with them, but not a wheelchair.
- Very young passengers require written consent from a parent or guardian. This is kept by the driver at the end of the journey. If required, children must bring their own booster seat.
